SCHEDULE A to ATTESTATION

1. During the Network's COVID response from March 2020 until June 26th, 2020, St. Michael's Hospital restricted its limited, owned parking garage (150 parking spots) at 209 Victoria Street to staff only, to ensure that staff had a safe and affordable place to park their vehicles.
 - a. Staff had expressed a concern for their safety due to the limited public transportation and affordable parking options in the downtown core of Toronto. There were no complaints received from patients in regards to parking during this time.
 - b. The parking garage returned to normal operations as of June 26, 2020
