### Places that offer free dental Services:

#### West End Oral Health Clinic

They provide free dental services to low income people between the ages of 18 and 64 who qualify. Their services include: checkups, cleanings, fillings, extractions, X-rays.

## **Canadian Dental Care Plan**

Brand new plan offered by the Government of Canada that will cover many of your dental expenses.

If your family net income is less than \$90,000 per year, and you have no access to private dental insurance, you are likely eligible

Seniors over the age of 65, adults with a valid Disability Tax Credit certificate and children under 18 are eligible to apply in 2024.

People between ages 19 and 64 will be able to apply starting in 2025.

Many dental services will be covered including: teeth cleaning, exams, x-rays, teeth extractions, fillings, root canals, crowns, dentures, and more

Note: Depending on the dentist they may still charge you a small fee

## **Free dental programs for seniors**

### **Ontario Seniors Dental Program**

To be eligible, you must be aged 65 or older, your income must be \$22,200 or less, or \$37,100 for a couple.

Covers check-ups, cavities, tooth repair, x-rays, anesthesia, tooth infection, gum conditions, and partial coverage of dentures, anesthesia.

### **Toronto Seniors Dental Program**

To be eligible, you must be aged 65 or older, and the income cutoff is \$27,000 for single person.
