Family Practice Nurses support the health needs and care of patients across the lifespan. They focus on providing assessment, screening, healthy lifestyle support, education and chronic disease management with a goal of improving health outcomes. Family practice nurses work with all members of the health care team to support patient centered care.

SERVICES PROVIDED

Acute Services:

Walk-in assessment, telephone triage

Chronic Disease Management:

COPD, diabetes, smoking cessation, hypertension, post-hospital discharge, addictions, case management

Healthy Living:

Preventative health screening, well-baby visits, vaccination review, routine injections, breastfeeding support, prenatal care, motivational interviewing on lifestyle changes, service linkages, access to resources

- Nurses are available at each clinic and support many different types of appointments
- Depending on the reason for your visit, you may see a nurse at your next appointment
- Patients can book an appointment with nurses for vaccines and injections, blood pressure checks, wound care, wart treatment, education and additional health teaching
