We are writing to share that our clinics have flu vaccines and we encourage you to book an appointment with us! This year there are a few options for how to book your flu vaccine in one of our clinics. They include:

Weekend clinics at 80 Bond:

- Oct. 30 and 31 reserved for families with children. Previously for children under 5, but now open to children of all ages
- Nov. 6 and 7 open to any patient
- Nov. 13 and 14 open to any patient

Evening clinics:

Nov. 1-4 from 5 - 8 p.m. These clinics will run at the same site that we run our urgent care clinics. They include:

- Monday 80 Bond
- Tuesday 140 the Esplanade (St Lawrence Health Centre)
- Wednesday 95 Homewood (Wellesley St James Town Health Centre)
- Thursday 95 Homewood (Wellesley St James Town Health Centre)

Local site options:

If you would prefer to get your flu vaccine at your home clinic, please indicate this when booking your appointment. Each site has designated times to provide flu vaccines.

Please book appointments before coming to clinic

We encourage you to call or email us to book an appointment. This allows us to make sure we have enough supply of vaccine and controls the number of people in



clinics.

Seniors specific vaccines

All our sites currently have a limited supply of high dose senior's (65+) flu vaccine. Supplies however, can fluctuate week to week. Any of the vaccines available this season are great options for those aged 65+. Your best flu vaccine is the one you get first. Please do not delay vaccination waiting for a specific product.

You can call or email our clinics to book an appointment. Please call your local clinic and listen to the voice prompts. If you wish to only book a flu vaccine, please press 8. Our clerical team will be happy to assist you in booking your flu vaccine with us.
