Second dose COVID-19 vaccine: Which vaccine? (June 21Both the Pfizer-BioNTech



and Moderna mRNA vaccines are interchangeable, equally effective and safe for everyone over 18 years of age.

The following groups are eligible groups for an earlier second dose if they meet the timing below:

- Eligible health-care workers
- First Nations. Métis and Inuit adults
- Those with specific health conditions (i.e. transplant recipients, receiving active cancer treatment, receiving dialysis, taking antiCD20 medications)
- People aged 70 years and older
- People 12 years of age and older who live in a Delta hot spot (M9L, M9M, M9N, M9V, M9W, M6M, M6N, M4A, M4H, M3J, M3K, M3L, M3M, M3N, M1B, M1G, M1J, M1S)
- People 12 years of age and older who had their first dose on or before May 9, 2021
