, 2021) The following groups are eligible groups for an earlier second dose if they meet the timing below:

- [Eligible health-care workers](#)
- First Nations, Métis and Inuit adults
- Those with specific health conditions (i.e. transplant recipients, receiving active cancer treatment, receiving dialysis, taking antiCD20 medications)
- People aged 70 years and older
- People 12 years of age and older who live in a Delta hot spot (M9L, M9M, M9N, M9V, M9W, M6M, M6N, M4A, M4H, M3J, M3K, M3L, M3M, M3N, M1B, M1G, M1J, M1S)
- People 12 years of age and older who had their first dose on or before May 9, 2021
