

# Taking off (Doffing) PPE

## Part 1- Inside Room



Remove gloves using glove-to-glove skin-to-skin technique.



Perform hand hygiene. Include fingertips, rub thumbs in rotation and wrists



Untie waist tie; keeping upright posture as much as possible



Perform hand hygiene. Include fingertips, rub thumbs in rotation and wrists



Untie neck tie; keep arms/hands away from face and neck



Remove gown pulling away from you; touching only the inside



Perform hand hygiene

# Taking off (Doffing) PPE

## Part 2- Outside Room



Perform hand hygiene. Include fingertips, rub thumbs in rotation and wrists



Remove face shield using strap only



Perform hand hygiene. Include fingertips, rub thumbs in rotation and wrists



**Surgical Mask**

OR



**Integrated Mask/visor**

OR



**Fit-tested N95 Resp.**

*Surgical/integrated mask – Grasp ties or elastics at back and remove; avoid touching the front.*



Perform hand hygiene. Include fingertips, rub thumbs in rotation and wrists

*Fit tested N95 respirator - See Poster 74368 for steps to 'Taking off fit-tested N95 respirator'*

Where applicable, to conserve PPE, keep your mask/face shield on and proceed to next task with clean hands. If your next task requires gown and gloves put on a new set.
