

# Putting on procedure mask with earloops









- 1. Perform hand hygiene
- 2. Place mask over your nose/mouth with coloured/printed side facing out
- 3. Nose wire at top
- 4. Open the pleats to cover your chin and form the nosepiece lightly across the nose & cheekbones
- **5**. Put your fingers through the earloops
- 6. Place earloops securely around your ears

### **STEP 2 - Forming the nose piece**

- 1. Ensure the mask pleats are opened enough to fully cover your mouth, nose, and chin
- 2. Gently form (do not pinch) the nose wire over the bridge of nose

### **STEP 3 - Checking mask fit**

- 1. Make sure the mask is securely fastened around ears and fits well over your nose and chin. There may be some gaps. This mask will not give you a seal
- 2. Perform hand hygiene

## Taking off procedure mask with earloops



1. Perform hand hygiene

- 2. Remove procedure mask by grasping the earloops, pulling out to clear the ears
- **3.** Remove forward, away from your face Do not to touch the front of the mask (if you do, perform hand hygiene)
