Clinical Pharmacists

Clinical pharmacists at the Family Health Team work with the Health Care Team to provide **personalized medication reviews** and **evidence-based drug information**.

What We Do

Medication Reviews: Review of all medications (prescription, non-prescription and alternative remedies), especially for those on multiple medications or complex medication regimens.

Medication Issues: Assessment and management of issues such as: side effects; drug interactions, treatment alternatives, drug plan coverage, etc.

Medication Education: Provide information tailored to the individual patient to help improve understanding of medications, and manage health conditions and medications.

Drug Information: Provide general drug information for health issues or new drugs.

How to Book an Appointment

Contact the clinic to book an appointment with a pharmacist. Appointments can be in person, by telephone or by video.

You can also ask to book an appointment through your doctor, nurse or other health provider at the Family Health Team.
