Parking

- There are Green P lots across from the hospital's Queen St. entrance (multi-level parking garage) and behind Metropolitan United Church (outdoor parking lot) on the east side of Bond St.
- You can also park at the Eaton Centre, located one block west on Yonge St. at Shuter St.





Once you arrive to the hospital

Directions to the Cardiac Investigation Unit

- 1. Enter the hospital from Queen Street. Use the revolving doors located under the car ramp by the Second Cup coffee shop.
- 2. Walk straight ahead and you will see coloured lines on the floor. Follow the blue line that says 'Cardinal Carter Wing'.
- 3. Follow the blue line to the Cardinal Carter NORTH wing elevators.
- 4. Take those elevators to the 7th floor.
- 5. When you exit the elevators, look for the overhead sign 'Cardiac Investigation Unit (CIU) & Registration'. Proceed to the reception window to register. Please note we open at 7 AM for check in.

If you require assistance to get to this area, please utilize the Information desk at the Queen Street entrance. There are wheelchairs available at the entrance if required.
