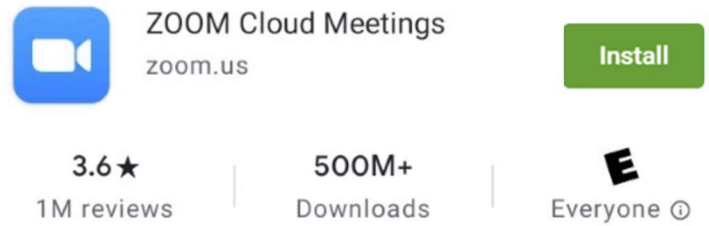


Zoom: Joining Home Video Visits Using Android Mobile Device

Download Zoom App


If you do not have Zoom downloaded on your device, go to 'Google Play Store' search for 'Zoom' and download the 'Zoom Cloud Meetings' app.




Test Zoom App on Device

Once the Zoom app is downloaded, test the audio and video by opening 'Google Chrome' on your device, and typing in zoom.us/test.

Tap on the 'Join' button, this will open a test call in the Zoom app.

In the next window, select 'Call over Internet' to enable microphone. Then tap  to start your video.

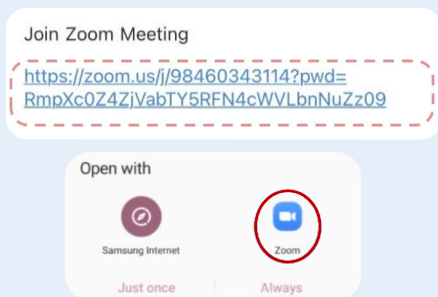
Overview of Zoom Call Functions



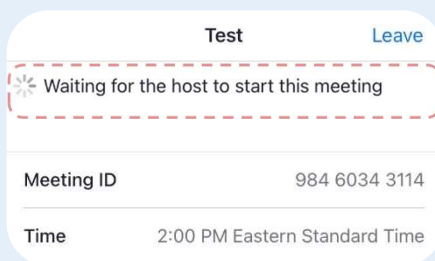
- Volume:** to turn the volume on or off.
- More:** to access more video call options such as swap to back camera
- Stop Video:** to turn video function on or off during the call.
- Mute:** to turn microphone on or off during the call.


Join Video Appointment

Open the video visit invite email, tap on the Zoom link, select the Zoom icon and tap 'just once' or 'always' to launch in the app.



You will be placed in a virtual waiting room until your provider starts the video visit.



To enable audio, select 'Call over Internet'. Then, tap  on the bottom left corner to start video.



Please note: you do not need to create a Zoom account to join the home video visit.
